

Qobin To Use Experience To Rejuvenate Umno Youth

SEPANG, Oct 9 (Bernama) -- The candidate for one of Umno Youth national executive council seats, Muhamad Muqharabbin Mokhtarrudin or better known as Qobin, wants to use his experience in the fields of sports and motivation to reach out to youth and rejuvenate Umno Youth.

Qobin, 31, who scaled the peak of Mount Everest in 2004, said he wanted to take on Umno President Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's challenge to transform and rejuvenate Umno by projecting a relaxing image to lure more young people to join the movement.
