

PM Attends Special Prayer Session At FT Mosque

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 13 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today attended a 'solat hajat' (special prayer) session with about 1,000 people at the Federal Territory Mosque here.
