

Six Vacancies In MPPG Yet To Be Filled By MCA

JOHOR BAHRU, Feb 11 (Bernama) -- Six vacancies for councillors in the Pasir Gudang Municipal Council (MPPG) for the period Feb 1 until Dec 31, 2015 have yet to be filled by representatives from the MCA.

MPPG President Onn Jabbar said he had received the list of six posts from the MCA but their appointment was still being postponed.

"This is the latest that we received from the state government," he said after the swearing-in ceremony for new councillors of the MPPG at the Menara Aqabah, here Tuesday.

The delay was due to internal problems within the party and he expected the problems to be resolved by March at the latest.

"We will delay the appointment up to March and by April we must be able to appoint them as MPPG council members. Until now, we have not received the actual date for the appointment because we are waiting for instruction from the state government," he said.

The postponement would not cause any problem to the MPPG in discharging its responsibilities, he said.

Fifteen council members took their oaths of office at the swearing-in ceremony, including six new faces.
