

Najib Praises German Twin Vocational Programme In Malaysia

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 30 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has praised the Performance Management And Delivery Unit (Pemandu) and the Malaysian-Germany Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MGCC) for cooperating to launch a German twin vocational programme in the country.

He said the twin programme could turn out more trained manpower for the country.
