

MIC Youth Ready To Assist BN In Kajang

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 9 (Bernama) -- MIC Youth are ready to go to the ground and assist the Barisan Nasional (BN) in achieving victory in the Kajang by election.

Its chief, C. Sivarraajh said he had directed the youth machinery to start regrouping for the campaign programmes.

The Kajang state seat was vacated by PKR assemblyman Lee Chin Cheh last month. He won the seat with a majority of 6,824 votes in a six-cornered tussle.

"We will not only focus on the Indian community but also other voters in expounding to them, the BN's achievements for the people compared to the contributions by Pakatan Rakyat after the two general elections in 2008 and 2013," he told a media conference after chairing the movement's first supreme council meeting today.

Based on the electoral roll in the 13th general election last May, Malay voters made up 48.48 per cent of the voters, Chinese, 40.46 per cent and Indians, 10.15 per cent;

Earlier, Sivarraajh said the 'My Indian Youth Consultative Council' (Miycc) which would provide interactive services and consultation for Indian youths would be launched next month.
