

MCA To Draw Up Comprehensive Blueprint For Chinese Community

MELAKA, Feb 24 (Bernama) -- MCA will come up with a more comprehensive blueprint for the development of the Chinese community.

This is in line with the decision made at the party's extraordinary general meeting (EGM) on Sunday for its leaders to accept the government posts offered at all levels, which paves the way for MCA to return to the cabinet.
