

**Khalid has not signed MB resignation letter because there's no such letter**

Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim (pic) has denied a news report that he had refused to sign a post-dated letter of resignation, which would pave the way for Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim to take over as Selangor Menteri Besar.

The Selangor Menteri Besar said he did not know of such a letter.

"The story is not true. No such letter. I don't have to comment on this matter. I will just do my job," said Khalid today, after launching a local government initiative to provide more CCTV systems in neighbourhood.

The Star reported on Saturday that Anwar's grand design to become the Mentri Besar of Selangor may be unravelling after Khalid refused to resign.

It reported that according to high-level sources, Khalid was to sign a post-dated letter of resignation drawn up by the PKR leadership, but had avoided doing so.

The letter is believed to be dated March 23 – the day when Kajang voters go to the polls.

The letter is premised on the assumption that Anwar will win the Kajang by-election, join the Selangor Legislative Assembly and move into the Mentri Besar's post.

Khalid today reiterated his earlier call that the position of Selangor Menteri Besar is not be a subject of speculation as the PKR was focused on the Kajang by-election on March 23.

"This issue is a subject of much speculation. This is not some Tamil or Indonesian drama," he said, adding that what was important at this time is PKR's victory. - February 17, 2014.
