

Terengganu menteri besar says he is prepared to be investigated by MACC

Terengganu Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Ahmad Said (pic) is prepared to be investigated by the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) for alleged misappropriation involving government projects in Terengganu as claimed by the opposition.

"I am ready to be investigated by the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission... I leave it to the MACC to resolve the matter," he told reporters after opening the Sekolah Kebangsaan Bukit Mentok Parent-Teacher Association's annual general meeting in Kemaman today.

He also described the report made by Batu Burok assemblyman Dr Syed Azman Syed Ahmad Nawawi as nothing more than a political game.

Yesterday, Syed Azman together with Terengganu PKR chairman Azan Ismail and Kuala Terengganu MP, Datuk Raja Kamarul Bahrin Shah Raja Ahmad, submitted what they claimed were documents related to the misappropriation to the MACC in Kuala Lumpur.

They handed over six documents regarding the matter, namely those involving issues on Pasar Payang, logging, mining, East Coast Expressway 2 and the Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin Stadium.

Ahmad said he would give the MACC his full cooperation to facilitate investigations.

"On anything else... I will not comment," he said.
