

Abdul Taib Attends Swearing-in Ceremony Of Sarawak Cabinet And Assistant Ministers

KUCHING, March 3 (Bernama) -- Sarawak Yang di-Pertua Negeri Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud and his wife Puan Sri Ragad Kurdi Taib today attended the swearing in ceremony of state cabinet members and assistant ministers.

The ceremony held at Dewan Lapau, Sarawak State Legislative Assembly in Petra Jaya was also attended by Chief Minister Tan Sri Adenan Satem, and his wife Puan Sri Jamilah Anu.

The ceremony began with the Registrar of Ceremony introducing the members of the state Cabinet and assistant ministers for an audience with Abdul Taib to receive their Letters of Appointment.

It proceeded with state Cabinet members and assistant ministers taking their oaths before the Yang di-Pertua Negeri witnessed by Adenan before signing their letters of oath.
