

Charoen Pokphand Signs Mou on Internship With College

REMBAU, March 4 (Bernama) -- Charoen Pokphand Jaya Farm (M) Sdn Bhd (Charoen Pokphand) has signed a memorandum of understanding with the Datuk Lela Maharaja Vocational College(KVDLM)here to provide internships for its students.

The pioneer batch will comprise 12 students selected for the programme under the National Dual Training System.

They will receive a certificate of competency upon completing 30 per cent of theory at the college and the reaming 70 per cent internship training over two years at Charoen Pokphand.

Charoen Pokphand's employees will assist in developing the student assignments and training activities, as well as instruct, evaluate and supervise them during the internship.

Deputy Director (Development) of the Technical and Vocational Division in the Ministry of Education Zakaria Mohd Noor said although the MoU signed today focused on poultry, the hope is that, it could be developed into the processing of agricultural products and livestock.

"We are also looking at the possibility of introducing our students to entrepreneurship through agro-kiosk activities," he added, after the signing ceremony at the college.

Charoen Pokphand has 40 years of experience in raising and processing table chickens and recently established a poultry project with local breeders.

Zakaria signed the MoU for KVDLM, and Pratan Jong Pun, President of Charoen Pokphand Holdings (M) Sdn Bhd, for the company.
