

Lam Thye Urges Malaysians To Rally Behind Authorities Over Missing Plane Incident

KUALA LUMPUR, March 9 (Bernama) -- National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (Niosh) chairman Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye Sunday called on all Malaysians to rally behind the various authorities in managing the missing Malaysia Airlines (MAS) plane incident.

He said in a statement the various agencies and relevant parties concerned were doing the best under very trying circumstances to locate the missing aircraft, passengers and crew.

"I was shocked over the missing MH370 flight from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing and call on all Malaysians to pray for the safety of all the passengers and crew on board.

"I hope the families of the passengers would remain calm and also pray for the safety of all their loved ones," he said.

MAS Flight MH370, carrying 227 passengers, including two infants, and 12 crew, went missing en route from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing about an hour after taking off from KLIA at 12.41 am Saturday. It should have landed in Beijing at 6.30 am.
