

Boeing Joins US Board As Technical Adviser To Locate Missing MH370

KUALA LUMPUR, March 11 (Bernama) -- Boeing has joined the US National Transportation Safety Board team as a technical adviser.

In a statement issued from Seattle, the aircraft manufacturer said the team is positioned in the region to offer the assistance.

Boeing said it continued to offer its thoughts and deepest concern to the families of those aboard Malaysia Airlines Flight 370, which went missing on March 8.

Malaysia Airlines confirmed that the flight, carrying 227 passengers from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing, lost contact with Subang Air Traffic Control at 2.40am Saturday.

The plane, which also carried 12 crew, had departed the KL International Airport at 12.41am and was scheduled to land in Beijing at 6.30am the same day.
