

Stop Accusing Govt Of Not Being Caring, Tajuddin Tells Opposition

KAJANG, March 14 (Bernama)-- The opposition should stop accusing the Barisan Nasional (BN) government of not being caring in campaigning for the Kajang by-election, said Deputy Minister of Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Datuk Tajuddin Abdul Rahman.

He said the overflow of assistance channeled to the people, including the National Entrepreneur Group Economic Fund (Tekun) should be seen as the government's success in uplifting and transforming the livelihood and wellbeing of the people to become successful entrepreneur .

"They (opposition) should stop making such accusations," he told reporters after a "meet the entrepreneurs" sessions with 500 Tekun entrepreneurs here today.

He said since Tekun was introduced in 1998, a total of RM3.18 billion had been set aside, benefiting 283,227 Malay and Bumiputera entrepreneurs.

"This is a commitment of the ruling government in helping the people, and of the amount, a total of RM447 million was channeled to 33,354 entrepreneurs in Selangor," he added.

Nomination for the by-election is on Monday and polling on March 23.
