

**1.7 Million BR1M Applicants Will Know If They Qualify Next Week - Husni

IPOH, March 15 (Bernama) – A total 1.7 million applicants for the 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) who are still in the checklist will know their status next week.

Second Finance Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Husni hanadzlah said of the total, the Internal Revenue Board (IRB) was also conducting a check on 500,000 applicants for BR1M 2.0 which ends today.

“Applicants will receive letters from next week on whether their applications have been approved or otherwise. Those rejected can appeal to IRB,” he told reporters after the ‘Let’s have Breakfast’ programme with residents of Tambun here, Saturday.

He said IRB carried out the check, following numerous problems which cropped up involving particulars and confirmation of applicants.

“Doubtful applications include invalid identity cards, incomplete information and others,” he said, adding that IRB’s check involved the Employees Provident Fund, Pension Trust Fund and several other agencies.

Ahmad Husni said applicants who did not qualify for the aid could appeal by referring to the IRB website or by visiting its office.
