

**Rosmah Urges Parents to Advise Children Against Speculating On Missing MH370**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 15 (Bernama) – Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor has advised parents in the country to monitor and advise their children against speculating on the missing Malaysia Airlines (MAS) MH370 aircraft.

The prime minister's wife said this was imperative as such speculation on the social site or other medium was unhealthy.

“What is the most important is that parents at home should advise their children against speculating because it is unhealthy for the country, under current circumstances, as the families of the aircraft passengers are sad and heart-broken.

“Rightly we should also empathise with them, delve into their feelings and continue to pray that the aircraft was promptly located,” she said.

Rosmah said this when she was a guest on the ‘What Women say’ programme aired by Radio Televisyen Malaysia here Saturday.

The Beijing-bound Boeing 777-200ER MAS-owned aircraft with 227 passengers and 12 crew members was reported to have gone off radar about an hour after leaving the Kuala Lumpur International Airport at 12.41 am last Saturday.

The search and rescue (SAR) operation, which had entered its eighth day today, has yet to detect the aircraft.

Rosmah also called on all Malaysians to be united and pray for the SAR to be successful.

“Let us to be united and continue to pray for the safety and well-being of the passengers,” she said.
