

Umno's Struggle To Develop Country Consistent With Islamic Teachings - Muhyiddin Bernama

KOTA BAHARU, April 1 (Bernama) -- Umno's struggle to develop Malaysia is consistent with Islamic teachings and this was verified by many quarters, Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said.

He said the situation in the country, which is now rapidly developing and prospering, was also in line with Islamic teachings and it had become a model for other countries.

"Umno's struggle is in line with Islamic teachings and I stress that what we have done in developing the country has never contradicted Islamic laws.

"From the education system at the primary level, all are centered on religion because what is important is to have a country which is developed with the people living in peace and prosperity," he said in his speech when opening the Kelantan Wanita Umno's Ta'lim-An Nur squad at the 8th Brigade infantry headquarters here Tuesday.

Also present were Kelantan Umno liaison chief Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, Federal Territories Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor, Kelantan Umno treasurer Datuk Dr Awang Adek Hussin and State Wanita Umno leader Senator Datin Rahmah Mahamad.

Muhyiddin said when the government places Islam at the forefront in all matters, it actually wants to make Malaysia the best model of an Islamic nation.

"I want to refute what PAS said to us, that our government does not follow Islamic teachings. We have to correct that perception and prove that what we have been doing is right.

"What the Wanita Umno is doing today is proof that we embrace Islam in our struggle," he added.

The deputy prime minister returned to Kuala Lumpur after the event.
