

**Terengganu LPP Records RM2.1 Million Profit Last Year**

KUALA TERENGGANU, April 2 (Bernama) -- The Terengganu Farmers' Organisation Authority (LPP) has raked in a profit of RM2.1 million last year, generated by 15 area farmers' organisations (PPKs) and a state farmers' organisation.

State LPP Director Shamsuddin Mat Rani said the PPKs achieved a total revenue of over RM83 million last year.

"The revenue was generated through activities of the PPKs to its members and the farmers' organisation's corporate projects," he told Bernama.

Shamsuddin said among the activities were marketing of agricultural produce, marketing of rice, supply of agriculture inputs and services for farm machinery.

On corporate projects, he said these included oil palm plantations, transportation and fish cage farming.

"LPP, through the PPKs, has successfully produced 375 entrepreneurs in various fields including watermelon farming, services and agro-based industries.

"Currently, 20 of them earn more than RM5,000 a month," he said.

Shamsuddin also said there was a proposal to establish a rice milling factory in PPK Gerai to complement the value chain in rice production.

"The rice mill would complete the value chain of the paddy production process," he said, adding that the PPKs had previously only engaged in the production of seeds, plowing, planting and rice harvesting.
