

Najib Arrives In Vietnam For Three-Day Official Visit

HANOI, April 3 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak arrived here for a three-day official visit in Vietnam.

He arrived at the No Bai International Airport at 9.30pm (local time), from Perth, Australia.

The prime minister, accompanied by wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor and Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman, was greeted on arrival by Malaysian Ambassador to Vietnam Datuk Azmil Zabidi, Vietnam Foreign Minister Pham Quang Vinh and Vietnamese Ambassador to Malaysia Nguyen Hong Thao.

From the airport, Najib was taken to his hotel, where he was greeted by International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob and the Malaysian Embassy staff there.

Tomorrow, Najib is scheduled to pay a courtesy call on Vietnam President Troung Tan Sang at the Presidential Palace and then have a four-eyed meeting with his counterpart, Nguyen Tan Dung.

Later in the afternoon, the prime minister is scheduled to visit the site of the Gamuda City development, a project costing US\$3 billion and developed by Malaysia Gamuda Berhad.
