

**Najib, F1 Racers Observe One-Minute Silence To Remember MH370 Tragedy**

SEPANG, March 30 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak together with 22 racers of the Formula One Malaysia Petronas Grand Prix 2014 observed a minute's silence in remembrance of the passengers and crew of the Malaysia Airlines (MAS) flight MH370 at the Sepang Circuit, here, Sunday.

The Formula 1 team displayed the sticker 'Remembering MH370','Pray for MH370' and "Doa untuk MH370" on their helmets as a remembrance of the 239 passengers and crew of the missing flight MH370.

Spectators present also observed the one-minute silence and together sang the national anthem 'Negaraku' before the race started at 4pm.

Also present to watch the race were Youth and Sports Minister Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar, former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and chairman of the Sepang International Circuit (SIC) Datuk Mokhzani Tun Dr Mahathir.

The flight MH370, which carried 227 passengers including 152 Chinese nationals and 12 crew members, disappeared on March 8 about one hour after taking off from the KL International Airport at 12.41am. The aircraft was scheduled to land in Beijing at 6.30am on the same day.

Najib then announced on March 24, seventeen days after the disappearance of Flight MH370, that it "ended in the southern Indian Ocean".
