

Seoul shares open above 2,000 points for the first time in 3 months

Seoul shares opened above the psychologically important 2,000 point level for the first time in three months today morning, tracking Wall Street higher on upbeat US factory activity that improved risk appetite.

The Korea Composite Stock Price Index opened up 0.4% at 2,000.13 points, opening a session above the 2,000 point level for the first time since January 2.

The index is currently at 1,997.77 points as of 0008 GMT (8.08am, Malaysia time). – Reuters, April 2, 2014.
