

DAP Member Questions Validity Of DAP Candidate For Bukit Gelugor

BUTTERWORTH, May 12 (Bernama) - A DAP lifetime member today questioned the validity of Ramkarpal Singh, the DAP candidate for Bukit Gelugor parliamentary by-election.

G. Asoghan said Ramkarpal's candidacy was invalid as the Registrar of Societies (ROS) did not recognise the legitimacy of the party's Central Executive Committee (CEC).

"If Ramkarpal contests using the DAP logo, the win can be revoked by the court on technical grounds," he told reporters, here today.

Asoghan also questioned the membership of Ramkarpal who joined the DAP earlier this year as the DAP did not receive recognition from ROS at that time.

"This is a scam because the CEC is not recognised by ROS and cannot recruit members.

"Thus, ROS should investigate Ramkarpal's membership," said the former chairman of Bagan Luar DAP branch.

The Election Commission (EC) and ROS should explain the validity of the DAP candidate and why the party was allowed to contest using the rocket symbol.

He said CEC members did not have the authority to sign the letter on behalf of DAP as they were not recognised by ROS.

The ROS letters dated April 17 and December 6, 2013 stated that they did not recognise the legitimacy of the CEC.
