

GTP, ETP Yields Good Revenue Last Year: Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, May 13 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said today that 2013 had brought much revenue to the country following the drafting and implementation of the Government Transformation Programme (GTP) and Economic Transformation Programme (ETP).

According to the Prime Minister, both programmes were introduced to bring progress to Malaysia and achieve the national aspiration of becoming a high-income developed nation by the year 2020.

"At the official launching of the National Transformation Programme 2013 at Angkasapuri last night, I repeated my confidence that we are now on the right track to achieve this aspiration," said Najib in his latest posting in his Facebook.

When launching the GTP and ETP Annual Report 2013 last night, among others, Najib said the GTP 2.0 succeeded in achieving 104 per cent success from its overall target in 2013 with a significant result in empowering individual and social economy.

He also said that the success factor could be seen from the considerable benefits enjoyed by the people, including through the granting of additional 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) 2.0 involving an allocation of RM2.91 billion which was enjoyed by more than 4.8 million low-income households.
