

PCM Criticises Azmin Ali's Remarks On 'Parti Cari Makan'

GEORGE TOWN , May 13 (Bernama)-- Vice- President of Parti Cinta Malaysia (PCM) Datuk Huan Cheng Guan on Tuesday criticised Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) deputy president Mohamed Azmin Ali's remarks, describing the party as 'Parti Cari Makan' probably to imply it is a hangers-on party.

He said Azmin should not act in such a way but rather keep healthy campaign throughout the campaign period in the Bukit Gelugor by-election.

"That is not the way it should be, we do not hit below the belt...they should uphold gentlemanly political practice. Why must stop cursing people around, this is not our culture," he said at a press conference here.

Azmin has labeled PCM in his political campaign speech at Keadilan Bukit Gelugor operation room last night, as 'Parti Cari Makan' and proxy of Barisan Nasional (BN) in the Bukit Gelugor by-election.

Huan, who is locked in a four-corner fight between Ramkarpal Singh, 38, of DAP and two other independent candidates of Mohamed Nabi Bux Mohd Nabi Abdul Sathar, 63, and Abu Backer Sidek Mohamad Zan, 46, said the issue would be brought up in the party's committee meeting for further action.

He also urged the Election Commission not to lodge police reports against youths involved in distracting the nomination process on Monday but rather those who masterminded it.
