

DAP Should Leave Pakatan Rakyat if Determined to Reject Hudud Implementation - MCA

KUALA LUMPUR, MAY 6 (Bernama) -- MCA today urged DAP to leave the opposition coalition to prove they are determined to reject hudud, the Islamic penal code.

Its vice-president, Datin Paduka Chew Mei Fun in a statement here today said DAP should apologise to the people for its actions instead of just telling PAS to leave Pakatan Rakyat because Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) was not seen as rejecting hudud either.

"We have not seen DAP taking any practical action to stop PAS from tabling the Private Member's Bill but continue to blame MCA on this issue.

"It is regrettable to see DAP's craze for power has neglected the interest of the people.

"How can two sets of criminal law not interfere with each other when we are living in the same environment. The conversion conflicts are the best evidence where no one is spared from two types of judiciary and that DAP and PAS are irresponsible to mislead the people," she said.

Kelantan PAS, through its parliamentarians, plans to table a Private Members' Bill on hudud in the Dewan Rakyat to get approval to implement the state's Syariah Criminal Code Enactment (2) 1993 by December.
