

**Make Your Stand Clear On Hudud - Teng

GEORGE TOWN, May 9 (Bernama) -- Penang Barisan Nasional (BN) wants the DAP-led state government to clarify its stand on the implementation of hudud law.

Its chairman, Teng Chang Yeow said the state government was confusing the people when they had earlier agreed in their 13th general election (GE13) manifesto with PAS.

"Lim had announced yesterday that Penang government rejectd hudud but their manifesto in 2013 itself stated that they will allow PAS to implement the Islamic nation," he told reporters here Friday.

He said under the manifesto signed by DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng in 2013, PAS was allowed to carry out their 'aqidah and Islamic nation'.

He also said that the Penang Islamic Religious Council (MAIPP) had earlier last month announced its stand to support Hudud.

"This is a political bluff and DAP needs to show some responsibility by explaining to the non-muslim friends what is happening," he said.

Teng, who is also the Penang Gerakan Chairman said the state government must clear its stand before urging others to do so.

He said Gerakan was always clear on its stand against hudud since the first day this issue arose.

It was reported today that Lim, who is also the Penang Chief Minister, announced the DAP-led state government rejected any move to implement hudud.

Meanwhile, MCA vice-president, Datin Paduka Chew Mei Fun said it was important for the people to understand what was the impact of PAS hudud law.

She said the party's political education bureau led by her would organise a seminar "Hudud Law & You" this Sunday at Dewan Kompleks Farlim from 2pm to 5pm.

"MCA is very clear on its stand on this and we want to share this with the rakyat what our view is," said Chew, who is also Penang MCA Liaison Committee chairman.
