

**Puteri Umno To Re-strategise In Facing Bukit Gelugor, T. Intan By-elections**

KUALA LUMPUR, May 9 (Bernama) -- The experience gained in the Sungai Limau and Kajang by-elections will help Puteri Umno to re-strategise in facing the upcoming Bukit Gelugor and Teluk Intan by-elections, said its vice head Zahida Zarik Khan.

She said although the Barisan Nasional (BN) lost both the by-elections, the experience gained put Puteri Umno in a better position to help the BN to be victorious in future elections.

"We are all set (to face the by-elections), we will be going all out to help the BN to wrest the seats from the opposition," she told reporters after attending a Mother's Day celebration with senior citizens and disabled people at Pusat Jagaan Warga Emas dan OKU Nur here today.

Both the parliamentary seats which are held by the DAP became vacant following the deaths the incumbents.

Karpal Singh, the incumbent for Bukit Gelugor died in a road accident on April 17 while the incumbent for Teluk Intan, Seah Leong Peng, died on May 1 due to cancer.

Polling for Bukit Gelugor is on May 25 while for Teluk Intan on May 31.
