KUALA LUMPUR, May 16 (Bernama) -- The government and people of Malaysia are very committed towards human rights values and principles even though the country comprises of various races and religious backgrounds, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) is a declaration adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on Dec 10, 1948 at the Palais de Chaillot, Paris.

The Declaration arose directly from the experience of the Second World War and represents the first global expression of rights to which all human beings are inherently entitled.
