

**NUCC Plans To Present Preliminary Report To PM By This July**

KUALA LUMPUR, May 18 (Bernama) -- National Unity Consultative Council (NUCC) plans to present to the prime minister by this July, a Preliminary Report based on the findings of the Unity Dialogue and a status report of the progress made towards the formulation of the National Unity Blue Print.

Its Deputy Chairman, Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye said NUCC has successfully conducted 18 Unity Dialogue sessions nationwide since it was established five months ago.

"Out of the total 5,530 participants, 1,159 of them gave their comments in writing by filling the questionnaire distributed and 512 people spoke up during the dialogues.

"The objective was to hear the voices of the grassroots as ordinary citizens in town hall type meetings," he said in a statement here Sunday.

According to the statement, NUCC met as a full council for the third time yesterday chaired by Tan Sri Samsudin Osman.

"At this meeting we took stock of the work accomplished so far by the council since Nov 25, 2013 when Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak launched NUCC.

"In addition we also set the agenda for the next six months," he said.

Lee said one of the key terms of reference of NUCC was the preparation of the National Unity Blue Print, with all activities so far focusing on gathering data, views, analyses and feedback from all sections of Malaysian society.

"It is not just about the finish project but equally important is the consultative and participatory process," he said.

NUCC also welcomes organisations and groups that have not yet participated in the dialogues and discussion to come forward and share their suggestions and recommendations for enhancing national unity, social cohesion and national reconciliation.
