

Najib Lauds NUCC's Efforts On National Reconciliation

KUALA LUMPUR, May 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has commended the National Unity Consultative Council (NUCC) for supporting his endeavour of national reconciliation.

"I thank NUCC for embracing my efforts on national reconciliation. These commendable efforts are in line with 1Malaysia," Najib said on his Twitter account.

Launched on Nov 25, 2013, NUCC was given the mandate to prepare a national blueprint for national unity and social cohesion. The 30-member council is chaired by Tan Sri Samsudin Osman.

NUCC deputy chairman Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye said Monday that the council had conducted 18 unity dialogue sessions nationwide to date.

An English daily quoted him saying that 5,530 people had participated in the sessions, with 1,159 people having contributed written comments through questionnaires distributed.

A preliminary report based on the findings of the unity dialogue and a status report of the progress made towards the formulation of the national unity blueprint would be presented by NUCC to the prime minister by July, the article said.
