KUALA LUMPUR, July 1 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak extended his condolences to the family of Muhammad Kamal Salleh Hodin who died at the site of the Bazar Ramadan, Presint 2, Putrajaya yesterday.

"News of the death of a civil servant at the Putrajaya Ramadan Bazar yesterday saddens me," he said in his Twitter posting today.

Muhammad Kamal, 34, a staff member of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, was believed to have fallen while stepping to cross the drain, about one metre wide, to buy food for breaking of the fast.

He was confirmed dead due to his head hitting the wall of the drain.
