

## **Four Envoys Present Credentials to King**

KUALA LUMPUR, June 20 (Bernama) -- Four new foreign envoys on Friday presented their credentials to the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah, at the Istana Negara.

They are Dr Anwar Hamadto Kassem Al-Agha of Palestine; Mohamed Fayaz (the Maldives); Khuseynov Muzzafar Makhmurodovich (Tajikistan) and Dr Mabaputhi Moorosi-Molapo (Lesotho).

Tuanku Abdul Halim and the Raja Permaisuri Agong, Tuanku Hajah Haminah, granted an audience to the envoys.

Also present were Deputy Transport Minister Datuk Aziz Kaprawi and Deputy Secretary-General of Bilateral Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Datuk Ramlan Ibrahim.

Anwar Hamadto, 47, has a doctorate in educational studies and had served as Palestine's ambassador in Sri Lanka and the Maldives.

Mohamed, 42, who is qualified in information security and computer crimes, had served in the Maldives' home ministry from 2012 to January this year before moving over to the foreign ministry.

Makhmurodovich, 39, joined the Tajikistan foreign service in 2002 and had served in the country's mission in Belgium and Uzbekistan.

Molapo, 60, who has a doctorate in educational studies, was a lecturer at the Lesotho National University before her posting to Kuala Lumpur.

Meanwhile, Tuanku Abdul Halim also presented the instruments of appointment to five Malaysian envoys.

They are Datuk Syed Sultan Mohd Idris, who will serve in Ireland; Datuk Mohd Ashri Muda (Argentina); T. Bala Chandran (Lebanon); Datuk Nor' Aini Abd Hamid (Uzbekistan) and Umardin Abdul Mutalib (Oman).
