

Share Information on P1MPIN, Najib Urges Malaysians

KUALA LUMPUR, June 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has urged Malaysians to share information on the government's initiative in providing the 1Malaysia National Insurance Plan for Hawkers and Petty Traders (P1MPIN).

"Without the petty traders, where can we get our burger and banana fritters? Let's share information among our friends on the P1MPIN initiative," he said in his latest Facebook post Friday.

The insurance plan, introduced by the government on Jan 1, 2013, gives 24-hour insurance coverage for accidents to hawkers and petty traders wherever they are, as a mark of the government's concern for their welfare.

Meanwhile, in another post in his Facebook, Najib said Malaysians must keep abreast of ever-changing trends lest they be left behind.

"Someone who is able to integrate business skills and social awareness will be able to capitalise on the modern and innovative business market," he said while sharing a BERNAMA news report Thursday headlined 'Social Entrepreneurship Skills Should Be Adopted By Students.'

The report quoted Harvey Sernowitz, Information Officer at the United States of America Embassy in Kuala Lumpur, as saying that social entrepreneurship skills, through a combination of business skills and social awareness, should be adopted by the younger generation, especially students, in order to become successful, young entrepreneurs and leaders of tomorrow.

Sernowitz made the remarks while closing the Click!Camp 4.0 to 100 participants of the Fulbright English Teaching Assistants (ETA) programme in Kuala Terengganu on Thursday.
