

## **MHB Signs Corporate Integrity Pledge**

JOHOR BAHRU, June 26 (Bernama) -- Malaysia Marine and Heavy Engineering Holdings Bhd (MHB) on Thursday became the 119th government-linked company to sign the Corporate Integrity Pledge (CIP), a joint initiative by the Malaysian

Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) and the Malaysian Institute of Integrity (MII).

Since the launch of the anti-corruption initiative, a total of 441 private sector corporates have signed the pledge to continue their commitment to a high level of accountability and transparency.

de Soras also said MHB launched the Anti Bribery and Corruption Policy and Guidelines Manual in April.
