

Tengku Adnan Will Discuss With Soup Kitchen Operators To Find A Mutual Solution - PM

KUALA LUMPUR, July 5 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said Federal Territories Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor will discuss with Soup Kitchen operators to find a mutually acceptable solution for all parties.

In his recent tweet, Najib said the government is very concerned about the plight of the homeless and poor and appreciate the role played by volunteers such as Soup Kitchen operators.

On Thursday, Tengku Adnan said Soup Kitchen operators would no longer be allowed to operate within a 2km radius of Lot 10, a high-end shopping complex which covers a large portion of the city centre, effective immediately.

The move is a serious effort by the government to rid the city of beggars and homeless people and the presence of Soup Kitchens feeding tarnishes the city's image, especially in terms of cleanliness.

However, Soup Kitchen operators refuted both claims.
