

Muhyiddin Breaks Fast With Media Practitioners

KUALA LUMPUR, July 8 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin broke fast with media practitioners and bloggers at Balai Berita of The New Straits Times Press (NSTP) today.

This was the second event attended by Muhyiddin at the media conglomerate company attended by about 1,000 people.

Among those present were Malaysian National News Agency (Bernama) chairman Datuk Abdul Rahman Sulaiman, Bernama Deputy Editor-in-Chief Datuk Zakaria Abd Wahab, Media Prima chairman Tan Sri Johan Jaafar and Kumpulan Utusan Editor-in-Chief Datuk Aziz Ishak.

During the event, Muhyiddin presented aid to 78 orphans from four schools in Selangor before performing maghrib prayer and tarawih.

Also invited were the five siblings who lost their parents in a hit-and-run accident in Cheras, Jalan Loke Yew in May.

The siblings - Mohammad Haiqal, 16, Fatin Adelina (14), Muhammad Aidil (10), Nur Syamimi (four) and Nur Auni Safiya (three) will receive collective assistance of RM450 from the Welfare Services Department to ease their financial burden until they reach 18 years of age.

In the incident, the parents, Jefri Mohd Zain, 46, and Noorsalawati Ibrahim, 40, were travelling in a motorcycle when the machine was hit by a sand-laden lorry. The couple died on the spot.
