

**Nothing unusual for Najib, Khalid to be at the same event, says

Deputy Speaker of the Selangor Legislative Assembly Nik Nazmi Nik Ahmad is keeping an open mind about the moral support shown by Putrajaya for beleaguered Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim, saying it is not an issue for him.

Nik Nazmi said the moral support shown by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak for Abdul Khalid was normal because they usually met at official functions.

"We cannot look at every single thing from a political party point of view," Nik Nazmi said.

"Take the Malay Rulers' functions for example, the premier will attend along with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong and the menteri besar will accompany the Sultan."

"Previously, when PKR de facto leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim attended his oath-taking ceremony, he also had a teh tarik with Najib.

"I don't see any major issues as I also have good friends in Umno," he told reporters at the Annexe Hall in Shah Alam today.

Najib had told reporters yesterday during a breaking of fast function in Bukit Jelutong that he could cooperate with Abdul Khalid despite their different political views.

"Although we have a difference in political views, we can work together on many issues," Najib said.

Abdul Khalid has, in recent months, come under pressure from various quarters within Pakatan Rakyat over his style of management.

There have also been calls for him to step down as the menteri besar. – July 11, 2014.
