

MCA condemns cow-head incident

MCA has condemned those behind the dumping of a cow head at the doorstep of DAP assemblyman R.S.N Rayer in Penang this morning, saying such actions only served to increase racial tension in the country.

"We condemn and abhor such an irresponsible action as it will only serve to disunite the nation," its president, Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai, said in Kuala Lumpur.

Liow, the Bentong MP, said all Malaysians should respect the various religious beliefs practised in Malaysia.

Rayer's wife alerted him when she made the gory discovery at the front gate of their house at 6.45am.

The Seri Delima assemblyman courted controversy last month when he uttered "Umno celaka" in the Penang legislative assembly.

In response, Umno members, especially from the Youth section, demanded an apology from Rayer and called for action to be taken against him.

However, Rayer did not link this morning's incident to his remark in the Penang assembly.

"I cannot say that this has to do with that... but this (the cow head) is

the first such incident I have encountered since then.” – June 28, 2014.
