

Azmin on course to retain deputy presidency, according to PKR polls results

The Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) election is set to see its deputy president Mohamed Azmin Ali retain his post, as results show that he is ahead of the two other contestants.

Azmin has so far obtained 21,066 votes, leaving behind Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim who has 14,608 votes while Datuk Saifuddin Nasution Ismail trails with 9,944 votes.

This is based on the tally obtained from 195 out of 198 PKR branches.

Of the three other branches, Pensiangan has already voted but the results have not been confirmed, while Kelana Jaya and Puchong have yet to vote.

"The full results of the election will be announced at the PKR National Congress to be held from August 22 to 24 at Stadium Melawati in Shah Alam," PKR election committee chairman Datuk Johari Abdul told a press conference at the party headquarters in Petaling Jaya today.

"So far, we have spent almost half a million ringgit on the polls," he added. – July 9, 2014.
