

MIC Wants Government To Act Against Sharul Hameed

KANGAR, Aug 1 (Bernama) -- The MIC will send a memorandum to Home Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi to take firm action against a freelance missionary for allegedly making derogatory remarks on Hinduism during his talks in Penang recently.

Its secretary-general, A. Peragas Rao stressed that stern action against the preacher, Shahul Hameed M. P. H Seeni Mohd would reflect the sincerity of the government in protecting racial unity, in line with the Cabinet's aspirations.

"Hindus have high hopes on the government to punish individuals out to create tension among the races, according to the law.

"The issue cannot be resolved with an apology," said Peragas who was met by reporters at an MIC convention for the Perlis liaison committees here Friday.
