

**Muhyiddin Attends Tahlil For Victims Of MH17**

PUTRAJAYA, July 20 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin tonight attended a tahlil held for victims of the Malaysia Airlines (MAS) Flight MH17 which went down in Donetsk, eastern Ukraine near the Russian border.

It was held at Sri Satria and also attended by Muhyiddin's wife, Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman.

Also present were representatives from various non-governmental organisations, including the Congress of Unions of Employees in the Public and Civil Services (Cuepacs), Malaysian Trade Union Congress (MTUC), Malaysian Youth Council, Malaysian Muslim Lawyers Association, Yayasan Dakwah Islamiyah Malaysia (Yadim) and the ex-servicemen associations.

At the function, Muhyiddin and Noorainee also presented contributions to students from Maahad Tahfiz Ar Rasyidin and Sekolah Tahfiz Al Ukhuwah Petaling Jaya.

The MAS flight, MH17, was flying from Amsterdam to Kuala Lumpur when it went down in Ukraine. It was carrying 298 people - 283 passengers and 15 crew.

The aircraft had left Amsterdam at 12.15 pm (Netherlands time) Thursday and was to have arrived in Kuala Lumpur at 6.10 am (Malaysian time) Friday.
