

Muhyiddin Gives Letter Of Consent To Universiti Islam Malaysia

PUTRAJAYA, July 24 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today handed the letter of consent to Universiti Islam Malaysia (UIM) President Tan Sri Dr Mohd Yusof Noor at his office.

Also present were Second Education Minister Datuk Seri Idris Jusoh, Education Ministry chief secretary Datuk Dr Madinah Mohamad and chief secretary II Datuk Seri Dr Zaini Ujang.

Mohd Yusof who thanked the Education Ministry said UIM which will start operations in Cyberjaya by end of the year would focus on Masters and Doctorate (PhD) programmes of study and ensure that those students selected were experienced and of quality.

"Only experienced students who wished to specialise in their respective fields will be offered a place. Apart from academic qualification, experience of individuals will also be given consideration," he said.

Mohd Yusof said the first programme to be offered would be in Financial Management.

"For a start only 10 students will be offered places," he said.
