

**Mustapa Hopes Najib Will Have Successful Visit To Netherlands**

JELI, July 30 (Bernama) -- International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed Wednesday expressed the hope that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak would have a successful visit to the Netherlands over the Malaysia Airlines Flight MH17 crash in Ukraine.

He said Najib's discussions with Dutch Prime Minister Mark Rutte would also cover the identification of the remains of the passengers and crew on board Flight MH17, bringing the remains of Malaysians to Malaysia and bringing to justice those responsible for the alleged shooting down of the plane.

"All the people of Malaysia are praying for God to shower blessings on the mission of Najib in his discussions," he told reporters at a 'tahlil' session at his residence here.

More than 5,000 people attended the session held for the victims of the Flight MH17 tragedy and for the successful visit of Najib to the Netherlands.

Mustapa, who is the MP for Jeli, said Najib had handled the incident with calm and had worked hard for a fruitful outcome.

"Datuk Seri Najib is known for being a great leader who has administered Malaysia into a highly regarded country. Malaysia is known as a peaceful and progressive country and, most importantly, it makes rational considerations," he said.

Flight MH17 crashed in eastern Ukraine on July 17 as it was flying from Amsterdam to Kuala Lumpur with 283 passengers and 15 crew on board. The Boeing 777 aircraft is believed to have been shot down over the troubled country.
