

**Selangor MB Must Attend Pkr Disciplinary Board's Hearing Session Tomorrow**

SHAH ALAM, Aug 7 (Bernama) -- The Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) Disciplinary Board today decided that Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim must attend the board's hearing session Friday.

PKR Disciplinary Board chairman Datuk Tan Kee Kwong said in a statement Thursday that the board had received Abdul Khalid's reply to the show-cause letter yesterday after issuing the letter last Tuesday.

However, he said, the board had also suggested another date, that is before 12 noon on Saturday, if Abdul Khalid could not attend the board's hearing session at the PKR headquarters tomorrow.

He said that at the hearing session, Abdul Khalid would be asked to explain the issue on the restructuring of the Selangor water industry; the Menteri Besar's new allowance; the tax increase for the business licence; the issue on Abdul Khalid's loan with Bank Islam and the proposed construction of the Lebuhraya Kinrara-Damansara (Kidex).

Earlier, Abdul Khalid was issued with a show-cause letter by the Disciplinary Board for ignoring the PKR decision to appoint a new Selangor Menteri Besar.

This was a follow-up to the decision of the Special Meeting of the Central Leadership Council (MPP) on July 21 which unanimously decided that PKR president, who is also the Kajang State Assemblyman, Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail would be the new Selangor Menteri Besar.
