

MCA Wants Penang CM To Answer Allegations On RM3.6 Billion Undersea Tunnel

GEORGE TOWN, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng should provide a detailed explanation on the RM3.6 billion undersea tunnel project to prove his innocence, said MCA Public Services and Complaints Bureau chairman Jason Teoh Sew Hock.

He said Lim appeared to be worried after PAS Central Committee member Nasruddin Hassan Tantawi, who is also Temerloh member of parliament, accused him of using direct negotiation in the construction of the first undersea tunnel in Southeast Asia.

"As head of state, Lim should prove his innocence by providing facts, instead of threatening to sue others.

"While embattled Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim was more than willing to be investigated over his decision to approve the Kinrara-Damansara Expressway, Lim Guan Eng behaved quite the opposite," he said in a statement here today.
