

PKR Polls: Claims Of Irregularities In Bayan Baru Division

KEPALA BATAS, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- A member of Parti Keadilan Rakyat's (PKR) Bayan Baru division has claimed there were irregularities in the division's polls held on May 4.

Assoc Prof Dr Zsmani Shafiee said among the discrepancies were members whose names were not on the electoral roll were allowed to vote.

He told this to reporters after lodging a complaint on the irregularities to the Penang branch of the Registrar of Societies (ROS) in Seberang Perai Utara here Friday.

He added that he was resorting to the action because his complaints to PKR's election committee on the matter did not bear any fruit.

Meanwhile, Dr Zsmani, who is also a PKR life member, weighing in on the menteri besar (MB) crisis in Selangor, said grassroots PKR members in Penang wanted Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim to stay on as the MB.

The crisis erupted as a result of the PKR leadership deciding to replace Abdul Khalid with PKR president and Kajang assemblyman Datin Seri Wan Azizah Wan Ismail as the new MB. Wan Azizah is also the wife of PKR de facto leader and federal opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.
