

'Kajang move' still on, says Anwar

Hours after the Selangor menteri besar announced that he will stay in power until the end of his term, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said today that the "Kajang move" will go on, reminding party members that it will benefit everyone.

The opposition leader, however, did not mention any names or spoke about rumours surrounding Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim's impending removal.

He said the move's objective was to spur change and lift Selangor's capability further.

"The court decision was manipulated to hinder my advances. The Kajang move was meant to push for change.

"As I had said before, the rationale was that although we appreciate and acknowledge all the efforts being done right now, all the successes and benefits, there is a room for improvement, to push the boundaries and convince the people further."

Anwar also reiterated that no one remained in the position of power forever. – July 16, 2014.
