

**Letter offering cushy deal for Khalid to resign is fake, says PKR

PKR has denied that its secretary-general Datuk Saifuddin Nasution Ismail (pic) issued a letter to embattled Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim, offering him a slew of compensations in return for his resignation.

The letter, which is circulating on social media platform Twitter, states that if Khalid agrees to step down, he would be appointed the chairman of the water restructuring committee, and Selangor economic adviser with an allowance of RM50,000 a month, with perks similar to that of a menteri besar.

It also mentions that all of Khalid's political and financial transgressions will be covered up and no investigations would be launched against him.

"I have contacted Saifuddin and received his confirmation that he did not issue such a letter," PKR communication director Fahmi Fadzil said in a statement today.

"In fact, the reference number used is also fake; 'JKD' refers to the disciplinary committee, and Saifuddin did not sign the committee's letter."

He said PKR condemned those who had fabricated the letter and said it was clearly done with malicious intent.

"It is evident that the letter has ill intentions and was done to raise doubts and ruin efforts to resolve the Selangor menteri besar issue amicably and according to procedure," Fahmi said.

PKR today gave its full support for its president, Datuk Dr Seri Wan Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, to replace Khalid as the Selangor menteri besar, completing the Kajang Move that the party initiated in January.

DAP and PAS are expected to also reveal their stand on the issue after both parties convene separately this Saturday.

But PAS president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang, alongside its spiritual leader Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat and the party's ulama wing, have thrown their support behind Khalid, causing a rift between the opposition pact parties.

Yesterday, PKR released a dossier to Pakatan Rakyat's top leaders disclosing six reasons why it wanted Khalid to be removed.

The party said the issues which affected the menteri besar's integrity included his RM66.67 million out-of-court debt settlement with Bank Islam and the subsequent deals on the sale of state land to developers, the controversial Kidex highway project, the Selangor water deal with Putrajaya and issues related to hikes in business licence fees, rubbish collection and potholes. – August 6, 2014.
