

Shuhaimi Slams PKR Vice President's Actions

SHAH ALAM, Aug 29 (Bernama) -- PKR state assemblymen today slammed party vice president Rafizi Ramli who urged them to withdraw from being named as Selangor menteri besar.

PKR information chief Shuhaimi Shafiei who is also state assemblyman for Sri Muda said Rafizi's call that they make an open statement on the matter was unnecessary as it was insulting to them.

"I do not think I and the other state assemblymen should be ordered to make a statement to withdraw as we were not nominated as candidate for menteri besar.

"Who is Rafizi to tell us to do this or that? If he has a suggestion which he thinks is good, take it to the Central Leadership Council for us to discuss and make a decision," he said in a statement here today.

Shuhaimi also questioned Rafizi's action in using the media to resolve the party's internal issues, casting a bad image on the party.

In a statement issued today, Rafizi urged PKR state assembly to do so in a open show of support for party president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail.

Yesterday, opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim urged all parties including PAS to accept the decision to choose Wan Azizah as the sole candidate for Selangor's new menteri besar as decided at the Pakatan Presidential Council meeting on Aug 17.
