

PKR Youth wants Azmin to be considered for Selangor MB

The PKR Youth wing (AMK) wants the party to consider party deputy president Azmin Ali for the position of Selangor Menteri Besar, as suggested by PAS.

AMK secretary Julailey Jemadi said it also welcomed the Islamists party commitment to remain in the Pakatan Rakyat.

"With this decision, we hope the three Pakatan parties will become a strong coalition to take on the Barisan Nasional and defeat it at the next general election," said Julailey in a statement today.

The AMK wing held a meeting immediately after PAS had announced its decision to nominate PKR president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail and her deputy, Azmin, for the Selangor menteri besar position.

"We will raise this with the leadership and hope they will consider this suggestion," said Julailey.

Earlier today Azmin urged all parties not to jump the gun over PAS's proposal to submit his name as one of the two candidates for the post.

"Let's wait for the Pakatan Rakyat leadership (to meet today). Let the council decide first, then I will comment," he told The Malaysian Insider today.

PAS deputy president Mohamad Sabu today announced the party's stand after its central committee meeting in Kuala Lumpur today.

"We have unanimously agreed to suggest two names to replace Khalid," he said.

The Pakatan Rakyat leadership council is meeting now and will make known its final decision later. – August 17, 2014.
