

Come clean about your wealth, C4 tells Najib

Anti-corruption group condemns anti-GST rally arrests, demands answers from PM.

PETALING JAYA: The anti-corruption group C4 has demanded that prime minister Najib Razak “come clean” about his personal wealth, in the face of mounting criticisms.

Cythia Gabriel, the C4 founding director, condemned the use of the Sedition Act against those who had raised questions about corruption, the wedding of Najib’s daughter and the debt-ridden government company 1Malaysia Development Bhd.

“How could public outcry over such devastatingly real issues be deemed seditious? How are questions related to public accountability and public money, deemed seditious?” she said in a statement.

She said Najib must immediately answer all questions related to the 1MDB controversy and put to rest growing suspicions of a fraudulent money trail that reeks of corruption.

He must reveal his personal wealth and declare his assets and sources of income, she said.

Recent press reports have highlighted the purchase of luxury properties in the United States by his stepson, and former prime minister Dr Mahathir Mohamad had also spoken publicly about lavish expenditure on the wedding.

Gabriel said the government must undertake prudent financial management urgently to stop wastages and leakages and repeal the Sedition Act.
